4. First Aid Measures	
Inhalation:	If symptoms develop, move victim away from exposure and into fresh air. Administer oxygen if breathing is difficult.
<u>Eyes:</u>	Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. If symptoms persist or if there is any visual difficulty, consult physician.
<u>Skin:</u>	Get medical aid. Flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. Wash off with soap and plenty of water.
Ingestion:	Get medical aid immediately. If conscious and alert, rinse mouth and drink 2-4 cupfuls of milk or water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Treat symptomatically and supportively. Consult a physician. Show this safety data sheet to the doctor in attendance. Move out of dangerous area.

5. Fire-Fighting Measures	
Suitable Extinguishing Media:	Use water spray, dry chemical, carbon dioxide, or chemical form. Use extinguishing measures that are appropriate to local circumstances and the surrounding environment.
